



# Shelby Johnson Memorial Scholarship

Any member of the Kenai Peninsula School District 2019 Senior class, current Juniors that will graduate in 2021, or any individual age 21 or younger (high school graduate or GED) who plans to pursue a career in a building-related field, and who will attend an eligible community college, university or vocational school in the State of Alaska, is eligible to apply for a Kenai Peninsula Builders Association (KPBA) scholarship. Up to four (4) \$1000.00 awards are available this year.

A building-related field includes but is not limited to: heating, ventilation, electrical or welding technology; carpentry, building trades, interior design, structural design, architecture, office management, etc.

All scholarship are in the form of a "Letter of Award" issued by the Kenai Peninsula Builders Association, and moneys will be released upon receipt of a "Verification of Enrollment" to be sent by the proper school authorities. Any scholarship funds paid to the school and not used will be returned to the Kenai Peninsula Builders Association before July 1, 2021. This award will not cover any payments for any academic year beginning prior to June 1, 2020.

**Applicants must send all school transcripts (if applicable) with this application, any personal references, and a personal essay outlining: goals, needs, accomplishments and objectives of the applicant. *Incomplete applications will not be considered.* You can fill this form out online instead by going to <https://kenaipeninsulabuilders.com/kpba-scholarship-application/>.**

#### Criteria for Scholarship Award:

- Applicant to attend an eligible community college, university or vocational school in the state of Alaska and will pursue a building-related career.
- Scholarship funds to be awarded in one payment of \$1000.00
- Any scholarship funds must be used or allocated one year after award.

Interviews will be scheduled after the scholarship deadline of February 14th. All applicants will be notified within one week of interviews as to whether they are to receive one of our scholarships.
